RESOLUTION NUMBER R-285314

ADOPTED ON FEBRUARY 6, 1995

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$7,500 from the Metropolitan Wastewater Department Fund 41509, CIP No. 40-921.0, Fiesta Island Replacement Project Phase II Pipelines, is hereby authorized, solely and exclusively for environmental mitigation to the City's Mitigation Fund Agreement 10517, CIP No. 76-751.0 (Bid K95108), and the City Manager is directed to implement the preferred alignment as shown in his memorandum of January 17, 1995 to this Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that within the budget for the above referenced project, an appropriation of up to \$500,000 from the Sewer Revenue Fund is to be used for reconstruction of the medians and for sidewalks where necessary along portions of the sludge pipeline route within the confines of the restrictions placed on said expenditures by San Diego Municipal Code section 64.0403. This money is in addition to the restoration required to return the community streets to satisfactory condition and to satisfy the requirements of the Americans With Disabilities Act.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is directed to replace the manual valve on Genesee Avenue between Marlesta Drive and Boyd Avenue, the valve on Mt. Abernathy Avenue between

Printwood Way and Redbrook Road, and the valve on Linda Vista Drive near Via Los Cumbres with electronic valves.
