RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 285405
ADOPTED ON FEB 27 1995

WHEREAS, on February 6, 1995, the San Diego City Council Committee on Rules, Finance and Intergovernmental Relations reviewed and unanimously approved Intergovernmental Relations Department (IRD) Report 95-2, dated February 2, 1995, concerning H.R. 794, the exemption legislation for the City of San Diego; and


WHEREAS, H.R. 794, proposed by Congressman Brian Bilbray and co-authored by the entire local Congressional delegation, is new legislation that will provide that the current treatment of wastewater discharged through the Point Loma outfall is the equivalent of secondary treatment, so that increasing the level of treatment is not required; and

WHEREAS, the Council Committee on Rules, Finance and Intergovernmental Relations expressed their full support of this legislation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Intergovernmental Relations Department is directed to

convey the City's support of H.R. 794 to the appropriate elected officials in Washington, D.C.
