WHEREAS, The City of San Diego has established a Competition Program to ensure that the citizens of San Diego receive the most cost-effective public services for their tax dollars; and

WHEREAS, the Competition Program includes an internal review process designed to identify potential program improvements that would make public services more cost effective and competitive; and

WHEREAS, the dead animal removal service has completed an internal review process which identified improvements which will reduce direct costs of the program by approximately \$32,000 or 20% of total program cost; and

WHEREAS, the Competition Program has completed a comprehensive competitive assessment of the dead animal removal service, including benchmarking City program performance with private providers; and


WHEREAS, the City provided dead animal removal service, as improved by the Competition Program, provides a basic public service with equal effectiveness and efficiency to outside providers; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to continue to directly provide dead animal removal services with the resources

allocated within the Environmental Services Department's Refuse
Collection Division, as contained in City Manager Report
No. 95-123.
