WHEREAS, the United States Navy intends to rehabilitate seven dwelling units and construct 412 new multi-family military housing units in the Eastern Area of the Mid-City Community; and WHEREAS, the 73.65-acre Chollas Heights Navy Family Housing site is currently under exclusive federal jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Navy is proposing to relinquish federal legislative jurisdiction of Chollas Heights in order for the City of San Diego to provide police and fire protection to the proposed Navy Family Housing Project ("retrocession"); and

WHEREAS, upon the City of San Diego's acceptance of the proposed retrocession, the Secretary of the Navy will request a hearing before the California State Lands Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego desires to work cooperatively with the Navy on the Chollas Heights Navy Family Housing project and other projects in the City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council hereby agrees to accept jurisdiction of the Chollas Heights property for the purpose of providing police and fire emergency services.
