## RESOLUTION NUMBER R-286112 ADOPTED ON JULY 18, 1995

RESOLUTION CONSIDERING THE PROTESTS,
APPROVING MODIFIED MAP, CONFIRMING THE
ASSESSMENTS, AND ORDERING THE PROPOSED
MAINTENANCE, IN THE MATTER OF THE MIRA MESA
LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the notice of the time and place fixed for the hearing of protests in the matter of "Mira Mesa Landscape Maintenance District," under Resolution of Intention No. R-285722, adopted on May 15, 1995, having been duly given in the manner required by law and the legal time for filing such protests and the time fixed for hearing thereon having passed; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- Except as modified herein, the protests, if any, are overruled.
- 2. Except as modified herein, the assessments described in Document No. RR-285723, on file in the office of the City Clerk and on file in the office of the Street Superintendent, are hereby confirmed and approved.
- 3. The modified assessment district map for the "Mira Mesa Landscape Maintenance District," described in Document No.

  M-343-1 is hereby approved.
- 4. The assessments levied for the upcoming fiscal year shall remain at the same level as the prior fiscal year.

- 5. The City Manager be and he is hereby directed to revise the Engineer's Report to conform to the lower assessments and activities.
- 6. As hereby amended, the maintenance described in said Resolution of Intention is hereby ordered performed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager be and he is hereby directed to do the following:

- 1. To work with the City Clerk and the City Attorney to examine methods for scheduling a binding community election in Mira Mesa next year regarding a compromise fee.
- 2. Review the City's procedure for Landscape Maintenance
  District hearings and recommend changes in the process which will
  allow for pre-addressed postcards allowing the voters to vote for
  or against the Landscape Maintenance District fee.
- 3. Return to the Rules Committee with recommendations regarding the changes for the October Committee meeting.
- 4. Work with the community leadership of Mira Mesa to review all of the funds available to the community including but not limited to FBA, landscape district, and the Mira Mesa Community Trust Fund, to identify possible ways to fund new landscape improvement projects, to build the park, and to improve park maintenance.
