A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AMENDING SECTION 707 (RESULTS; RUNOFFS) OF THE PROCEDURE FOR FORMATION OF PROJECT AREA COMMITTEE FOR THE CENTRE CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT TO PROVIDE FOR IMMEDIATE RESOLUTION OF A TIE VOTE.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego (the "Council") by Resolution No. R-276511, adopted the Procedure for Formation of the Project Area Committee (PAC) for the Centre City Redevelopment Project at its September 11, 1990 meeting; and

WHEREAS, there is sometimes an equal number of votes for more than one candidate running for a specific seat in a district during the PAC elections; and

WHEREAS, Section 707 provides for a runoff election in the event of a tie vote; and

WHEREAS, a runoff election has proven to be infeasible; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to establish a method for the immediate resolution of a tie vote; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that in the case of an equal number of votes for two candidates for a specific seat on the Project Area Committee, the tie will be broken by the toss of a coin by a neutral third party.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in the case of an equal number of votes for more than two candidates for a specific seat on the PAC, the tie will be broken by having the candidates draw straws, with the candidate drawing the longest straw declared the winner. If, for any reason, a candidate is not available to draw a straw,

a proxy will be appointed by Centre City Development Corporation staff to draw on the candidate's behalf.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council so amend the Procedures for the Formation of Project Area Committee for the Centre City Redevelopment Project.
