

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 286213
ADOPTED ON AUG 07 1995

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego that the low bids meeting specifications, of 1. ECDC ENVIRONMENTAL, L.C., 2. PIMA GRO SYSTEMS, INC., 3. FALCON DISPOSAL, INC., A GREENFIELD ENVIRONMENTAL COMPANY, are hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract for furnishing REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF AN ESTIMATED 140,000 TO 220,000 TONS OF DIGESTED SLUDGE, AN ESTIMATED 2,500 WET TONS OF SCREENINGS AND AN ESTIMATED 3,000 WET TONS OF GRIT, as may be required for a period of one year beginning August 10, 1995 through August 9, 1996 as follows:

1. ECDC ENVIRONMENTAL, L.C. - (Salt Lake City, Utah)

Category II, an estimated 90,000 wet tons of Belt Press Cake to Sanitary Landfill Disposal at a cost of \$32.75 per ton for a total estimated cost of \$2,947,500.00 (with a range of from 45,000 to 135,000 tons and a price range of from \$1,473,750.00 to \$4,421,250.00).

Category IV, an estimated 60,000 wet tons of Non-Class B Sand Bed Cake to Sanitary Landfill Disposal at a cost of \$32.75 per ton for a total estimated cost of \$1,965,000.00 (with a range of from 30,000 to 90,000 tons and a price range of from \$982,500.00 to \$2,947,500.00).

Terms net 30, with options to renew for three additional one year periods subject to the escalation terms specified in the bid documents.

2. PIMA GRO SYSTEMS, INC. - (Redlands, CA)

Category V, an estimated 60,000 wet tons of Class B Sand Bed Cake to Beneficial Use at a cost of \$28.85 per ton for a total estimated cost of \$1,731,000.00 (with a range of from 30,000 to 90,000 tons and a price range of from \$865,500.00 to \$2,596,500.00).

Terms net 30 days, with options to renew for three additional one year periods subject to the escalation terms specified in the bid documents.

3. FALCON DISPOSAL, INC., A GREENFIELD ENVIRONMENTAL COMPANY - (San Diego, CA)

Category VI, an estimated 5,000 wet tons of Screenings to Sanitary Landfill Disposal at a cost of \$34.85 per ton for a total estimated cost of \$174,250.00 (with a range of from 2,500 to 7,500 tons and a price range of from \$87,125.00 to \$261,375.00).

Category VII, an estimated 6,000 wet tons of Grit to Sanitary Landfill Disposal at a cost of \$34.85 per ton for a total estimated cost of \$209,100.00 (with a range of from 2,500 to 7,500 tons and a price range of from \$104,550.00 to \$313,650.00).

Terms net 30 days, with options to renew for three additional one year periods subject to the escalation terms specified in the bid documents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized to amend the contract with EDCD Environmental, L.C., to allow for beneficial use of biosolids to be disposed at the same price per ton as the original award of categories II and IV, contingent upon ECDC assuming all responsibility and accepting all liability for the development of a detailed procedures, instructions and a Quality Assurance/Quality Control program to ensure proper disposal in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event a contractor is unable to perform in accordance with specifications, the Purchasing Agent is authorized to terminate the contract and award to the next low responsible and responsive bidder, and to subsequent bidders, if necessary, until a bidder is found who can comply with specifications, or to obtain this service on the open market until it can be rebid.
