

RESOLUTION NUMBER R-286248

ADOPTED ON AUGUST 14, 1995

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that it be and it is hereby certified that the information contained in Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program, DEP. File No. 89-1426, dated May 26, 1995, in connection with NORTH CHOLLAS BURN SITE, on file in the office of the City Clerk, has been completed in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 and the State guidelines pursuant thereto, and that said Declaration reflects the independent judgment of The City of San Diego as Lead Agency; and stating for the record that the final Negative Declaration has been reviewed and considered by this Council prior to approving the project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that stating for the record, that the final Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program has been adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager be and he is hereby directed to do the following:

1. With respect to the North Chollas Burn Site, put the contaminated soil on the northerly site of the pit as far away from Marian Bear Park as possible.


2. With respect to traffic circulation, amend the present directions listed west on College Grove Drive to southbound on 54th Street and Euclid Avenue to Highway 94 to go from the site itself east on College Grove Drive and south on College Grove Way

to the ramp that goes to the freeway, so it would not go through any of the neighborhood down on 54th Street.

3. Have staff include Mr. Shaw's recommendation to show the following language: "At any time during a rain event, during the disposal of the ash, when there is water actually overflowing to catch basin, then the City would test that water on a daily basis until such time as it stopped overflowing into San Clemente Creek."
