RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 286267

ADOPTED ON AUG 15 1995

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING AND DECLARING THAT THE PUBLIC INTEREST, CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REQUIRE THE ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY FOR THE EXPANSION OF A PUBLIC PROJECT KNOWN AS PARK DE LA CRUZ, SAID PROPERTY SPECIFICALLY BEING LOTS 36, 37 AND 38 OF BLOCK 65 OF CITY HEIGHTS, LOCATED IN THE MID-CITY COMMUNITY, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA; AND THAT THE PUBLIC INTEREST, CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY DEMAND THE ACQUISITION OF FEE SIMPLE ABSOLUTE TO SAID PROPERTY FOR SAID PARK PROJECT; THAT SAID PROPERTY IS DEEMED NECESSARY FOR COMPLETION OF THE PARK DE LA CRUZ PROJECT AND DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO ACQUIRE SAID PROPERTY UNDER EMINENT DOMAIN PROCEEDINGS; AND DECLARING THAT AN OFFER TO PURCHASE THE PROPERTY PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 7267.2 HAS BEEN MADE TO THE RECORD OWNER OF SAID PROPERTY AND THE OFFER REJECTED; AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO COMMENCE AN ACTION IN THE SUPERIOR COURT OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, IN AND FOR THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDEMNING AND ACQUIRING SAID PROPERTY AND ACQUIRING IMMEDIATE POSSESSION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego has provided notice to those persons designated in Section 1245.235, Code of Civil Procedure and also has provided all persons a reasonable opportunity to appear and be heard on the matters referred to in Section 1240.030, Code of Civil Procedure; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the public interest, convenience and necessity of The City of San Diego, and the inhabitants thereof, require the acquisition of property for the expansion of a public park known as Park De La Cruz for community park purposes, said property specifically being Lots 36, 37 and 38 of Block 65 (3750-52 38th Street) located in City Heights in the Mid-City community, as more particularly described hereinafter, and that the City Council has found and determined the foregoing.

Section 2. That the public interest, convenience and necessity of said City, and the inhabitants thereof, demand the acquisition and taking of fee simple absolute to said property for the expansion of the Park De La Cruz Project, said real property lies within the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California.

Section 3. That Section 220, the Charter of The City of San Diego; Sections 1240.010, 1240.110, 1240.120, 1240.680, and 1255.410, Code of Civil Procedure; Parks and Playground Act of 1909; Sections 6950-6954, 37350.5, 38002, 38010, 40401(b), and 51063, Government Code; and, Section 61.0601, et seq., San Diego Municipal Code, permit the acquisitions referenced herein.

Section 4. That the parcel of real property sought to be condemned is described as follows:

Lots 36, 37 and 38 in Block 65 of City Heights in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, according to Map thereof No. 1007, filed in the Office of the County Recorder of San Diego County, October 3, 1906.


Section 5. That the taking and acquiring by said City of the real property hereinabove described is deemed necessary for the expansion of the Park De La Cruz Project for a community park; that such use is a public use authorized by law (Section 220, Charter of The City of San Diego; Sections 1240.010, 1240.110, 1240.120, 1240.680, and 1255.410, Code of Civil Procedure; Parks and Playground Act of 1909; Sections 6950-6954, 37350.5, 38002, 38010, 40401(b) and 51063 Government Code; and, Section 61.0601, et seq., San Diego Municipal Code); that for such public use, it is necessary that The City of San Diego condemn and acquire said real property; that said real property is to be used for the expansion of the Park De La Cruz Project which is planned and located in a manner most compatible with the greatest public good and the least private injury, and that the City Council has so found and determined all of the foregoing.

Section 6. That the offer required by Section 7267.2 of the Government Code has been made to the owners of record.

Section 7. That the City Attorney of The City of San Diego be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to commence an action in the Superior Court of the State of California, in and for the County of San Diego, in the name and on behalf of The City of San Diego, against all owners and claimants to an

interest in the above-described real property, for the purpose of condemning and acquiring the fee interests as above-described and obtaining immediate possession of said parcels for the use of said City.
