WHEREAS, Nan Valerio represented the Fifth City Council District as a founding member of the Tecolote Canyon Citizens Advisory Committee for eighteen years; and

WHEREAS, Nan, as one of the original appointees to the Tecolote Canyon Citizens Advisory Committee, played a key role in drafting the Committee's Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, Nan assisted the Tecolote Canyon Citizens Advisory Committee in all of its activities, including community meetings and design review of the newly constructed Visitors Center; and

WHEREAS, Nan's familiarity with legal requirements and experience in long-range planning led to the mapping of access points to Tecolote Canyon for disabled park visitors; and

WHEREAS, Nan helped to designate Tecolote Canyon as the nesting site for the Least Bell's Vireo and prevented further inroads into the canyon by urban encroachment; and

WHEREAS, Nan maintained a near perfect 90% attendance and voting record during her eighteen years of service on the Tecolote Canyon Citizens Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, during long hikes in Tecolote Canyon, Nan taught her five children and others to respect the park and its natural splendor; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego,

does hereby recognize and commend Nan Valerio for her dedicated efforts to preserve Tecolote Canyon as a natural resource park for San Diegans to enjoy well into the future.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Council does hereby honor Nan's eighteen years of community service by proclaiming Monday, September 11, 1995 to be "NAN VALERIO DAY" in The City of San Diego.
