

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 286278

RESOLUTION CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING TO AMEND
THE ASSESSMENTS IN THE HILLERY DRIVE TRAFFIC
SIGNAL COST RECOVERY DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, The City established the Hillery Drive Traffic Signal cost recovery district in 1992 to provide for the recovery of developer costs related to the construction of the improvements to the intersection; and

WHEREAS, Chapter VI, Article 2, Division 2, of the San Diego Municipal Code establishes a procedure for the creation of cost recovery districts and requires as an initial step in such procedure the holding of a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, The City Engineer and the City Auditor have reviewed the subsequent costs incurred by the developer and concur that they are appropriate and necessary for the district; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the final costs to be assessed to the Hillery Drive cost recovery district, hereinafter called "the District," are greater than the costs which were initially noticed; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:


1. That the foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The City Council does hereby set a public meeting and a public hearing to be conducted by the Council of The City of San

Diego on October 17, 1995, and October 31, 1995 at the hour of 10:00
a.m. in the Council Chambers of the City Administration
Building, 202 C Street, San Diego, California, to determine
whether the assessments for the properties in the district should
be modified to reflect the increased costs incurred by the
developer.

3. At such hearing all persons interested shall be given an
opportunity to be heard and said hearing may be continued from
time to time as may be determined by the City Council. The
decision of the City Council as to the changes to the District as
described above shall be final and conclusive.

4. The City Clerk shall notify all affected persons as
defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5, of the San Diego
Municipal Code.
