A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA AND THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, TO FACILITATE RELEASE OF SOCIAL SERVICE BLOCK GRANT FUNDS AND TO TAKE FURTHER ACTION AS REQUIRED BY THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, in June of 1994, The City of San Diego submitted an application for the Federal Empowerment Zone pursuant to Resolution No. R-283371; and

WHEREAS, the City subsequently was designated as an Enterprize Community by the Federal Government, such designation included a one time Social Service Block Grant of \$2.95 million, as well as other federal and state funds for programs that serve designated neighborhoods; and


WHEREAS, the City is required to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement between the City, State and Federal Governments before the funds can be released; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to enter into the Memorandum of Agreement with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and the State of California, Department of Social Services, a copy of the Memorandum of Agreement is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-286366.

2. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to carry out all future implementation requirements, including but not limited to the execution of an agreement with the State of California regarding fiscal requirements, finalization of program benchmarks, and establishment of a community-based governance structure for the program, as required by the Memorandum of Agreement.
