BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute said grant agreement, and that this authority shall include all aspects of program operation and

expenditures, under the terms and conditions of the approved grant program proposal, including any amendments or extensions thereof, and to certify that the City will comply with all applicable statutory and regulatory requirements related to said grant program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City manager is authorized to provide all matching funds as required under this program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that personnel positions funded by this grant award are not subject to local hiring freezes.
