A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE
MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY
OF SAN DIEGO ON TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 19, 1995.

WHEREAS, a municipal primary election was held in the City of San Diego on Tuesday, September 19, 1995, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. O-18183 (New Series), for the purpose of nominating candidates; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the certificate of the Registrar of Voters of San Diego County canvassing the returns of the municipal primary election, as certified to the City Clerk, has been duly received; and

WHEREAS, a canvass of these elections has been completed and the City Clerk has certified the results to the City Council;
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Council finds and determines pursuant to the provisions of Section 27.2206 of the San Diego Municipal Code, as follows:

I

The whole number of votes cast in the City was 49,007.

II

The total vote received by each municipal candidate at the municipal primary election is as follows:

A. FOR COUNCIL DISTRICT NO. 2 (three-year term):

Byron Wear and John Seymour are hereby declared to be the candidates for the office of Council District No. 2 in the general municipal election.

B. FOR COUNCIL DISTRICT NO. 4 (three-year term):

SHIRLEY N. WEBER	4,216
ELLINGTON DANIELS	415

Pursuant to Section 10 of the City Charter, GEORGE STEVENS, having received a majority of all votes cast in the Primary Election, is hereby declared elected to the office of Councilmember District No. 4.

C. FOR COUNCIL DISTRICT NO. 6 (three-year term):

VALERIE STALLINGS	9,624
MIKE PALLAMARY	7,114
ROLLA R. RICH	899
MARVIN DOUGLAS HENDRIX	660

Pursuant to Section 10 of the City Charter, VALERIE STALLINGS, having received a majority of all votes cast in the Primary Election, is hereby declared elected to the office of Councilmember District No. 6.

D. FOR COUNCIL DISTRICT NO. 8 (three-year term):

JUAN VARGAS

Pursuant to Section 10 of the City Charter, JUAN VARGAS, having received a majority of all votes cast in the Primary Election, is hereby declared elected to the office of Councilmember District No. 8.

III

The number of votes in each precinct cast for each person is recorded in the Election Returns Book, which book is a part of the records of this Council.

The City Clerk shall make public the results of the canvass of the municipal primary election by publication of a copy of this resolution.
