BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby recognize the outstanding contributions that the Mid-City Community Clinic, the Board of Directors, and the staff have made to improving the lives of all San Diegans.
