WHEREAS, the federal government has requested City assistance in the preparation of a Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement on Interim Discharge, with costs to be reimbursed to the City through the State of California.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to direct the City's existing as-needed environmental services consultant, Brian Mooney & Associates, to provide services for preparation of a Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement in connection with the International Treatment Facilities in the South Bay area.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the consultant Task Authorization for said additional environmental services shall be in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is directed to arrange reimbursement from the federal government, via a State Defensive Measures Grant, of all costs of said additional environmental services.
