A RESOLUTION ELECTING TO PROCEED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE PUBLIC STREETS, HIGHWAYS, AND SERVICE EASEMENTS VACATION LAW, DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE COUNCIL TO VACATE SEGMENTS OF: HIGHLAND AVENUE, 45TH STREET, AN ALLEY IN BLOCK 8 OF MAP 1001 AND ALLEYS IN BLOCKS 9 AND 9 1/2 OF MAP 1027 SPECIFIC TO THE ROSA PARKS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SITE; 29TH STREET AND "J" STREET SPECIFIC TO THE KIMBROUGH ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SITE; 44TH STREET, HIGHLAND AVENUE, AND ALLEYS IN BLOCKS 9, 10, AND 11 OF MAP 1028 SPECIFIC TO THE MONROE CLARK MIDDLE SCHOOL SITE; 39TH STREET, ALPHA STREET AND AN ALLEY IN BLOCK 2 OF MAP 1168 SPECIFIC TO THE CHAVEZ ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SITE AND FIXING A TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING THEREOF.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the public interest and convenience of said City require the vacation of segments of: Highland Avenue,
 45th Street, an alley in Block 8 of Map 1001 and alleys in
 Blocks 9 and 9 1/2 of Map 1027 specific to the Rosa Parks
 Elementary School site; 29th Street and "J" Street specific to
 the Kimbrough Elementary School site; 44th Street,
 Highland Avenue and alleys in Blocks 9, 10 and 11 of Map 1028,
 specific to the Monroe Clark Middle School site; 39th Street,
 Alpha Street and an alley in Block 2 of Map 1168 specific to the
 Chavez Elementary School site, hereinafter mentioned.
- 2. That it is the intention of said Council to order the vacation of segments of: Highland Avenue, 45th Street, an alley

in Block 8 of Map 1001 and alleys in Blocks 9 and 9 1/2 of
Map 1027 specific to the Rosa Parks Elementary School site;
29th Street and "J" Street specific to the Kimbrough Elementary
School site; 44th Street, Highland Avenue and alleys in Blocks 9,
10 and 11 of Map 1028, specific to the Monroe Clark Middle School
site; 39th Street, Alpha Street and an alley in Block 2 of
Map 1168 specific to the Chavez Elementary School site, as more
particularly shown on Exhibits A, B, C & D, on file in the office
of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-

- 3. That this Council hereby elects to proceed, in making said vacation under the provisions of the "Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law." California Streets and Highways Code section 8300 et seq.
- 4. That this Council hereby fixes 2:00 p.m. on

 November 6, 1995, in the Council Chambers on the twelfth

 floor of the City Administration Building, Charles C. Dail

 Concourse, 202 "C" Street, in said City of San Diego, as the time and place for hearing all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation.
- 5. That <u>The Daily Transcript</u>, a daily newspaper published and circulated, and of general circulation, in said City of San Diego, be, and it is hereby designated as the newspaper in which the Street Superintendent of said City shall cause to be published, in the manner and form required by law, notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention, and the Street Superintendent is hereby directed to cause notices of the passage of this resolution to be posted in the manner and form required

by law and to cause a notice similar in substance to be published in said newspaper in the manner required by law.
