RESOLUTION NUMBER R-286549 ADOPTED ON OCTOBER 31, 1995

WHEREAS, Item 337 on the Council docket of October 31, 1995, dealt with Carmel Valley Neighborhood 8A and other property; and

WHEREAS, after listening to the public testimony, reviewing the various documents involved, including the Manager's report and the environmental documents, and after Council discussion, there were still a number of questions with regard to the issues involved in the various discretionary actions; and

WHEREAS, one of the issues involved whether or not the City Council should proceed with discussions and potential actions relating to a portion of Neighborhood 8A or whether the other parcels and property ownerships within Neighborhood 8A should be included in actions relating to discretionary decisions for the area; and

WHEREAS, after discussion, it was determined that all of the various items relating to the discretionary decisions should be continued for further review; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that all of the items listed under Item 337 on the Council docket of October 31, 1995, are hereby continued for further review and potential additional recommendations by the City Manager, including the issue of whether or how all of the various properties in Neighborhood 8A could be reviewed and dealt with in a comprehensive fashion.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the one item relating to a potential amendment to the Neighborhood 10A Precise Plan, which involves the possible redesign of the wildlife corridor crossing the McGuire property, is hereby separated out from the other issues under Item 337 to be dealt with separately and independently by the City Manager, who is directed to bring that item back to the City Council as a separate matter with appropriate environmental documentation.
