

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 286626

ADOPTED ON NOV 27 1995

WHEREAS, from its very founding, viable avenues for travel and transportation have been critical to every aspect of life in the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, in California these critical avenues had their origin in El Camino Real and its tributaries of intersecting Indian trails that criss-crossed San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, from this primitive and historic beginning, a vast and sophisticated system of streets, roads, arterials and highways, bridges and interchanges now forms a keystone element of the composite and incomparable life flow of California; and

WHEREAS, on December 19, 1935 the San Diego Highway Development Association was incorporated with the following purposes:

To promote, carry on and forward the building, construction, improvement and maintenance of local, state and national highways; to advertise the same, and to encourage the use of said highways by the traveling public.

To participate and engage in all types of community and public enterprises and projects designed to serve the public, and to improve the economic and material well being of the community and its inhabitants.

To enter into, make and perform, and carry out contracts of every sort and kind which may be necessary or convenient for the business of this corporation;  
and

WHEREAS, throughout the intervening years, succeeding groups of men and women as members of the San Diego Highway Development Association have worked cooperatively with the commitment and dedication as business and community volunteers and agency officials to faithfully and effectively carry these evolving purposes declared with foresight and courage six decades ago;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby recognize the 60th Anniversary of the San Diego Highway Development Association and is hereby warmly and gratefully commended for its continuing and exemplary leadership and significant accomplishments in serving the needs of the people of San Diego in the virtual field of street and highway planning, development, construction and maintenance.
