WHEREAS, on the occasion of a heated debate on Jackson Drive, despite Jack's own misgiving on the subject, he saved the councilmember from a near lynching from an angry mob; and

WHEREAS, Jack has continued to distinguish himself as a community leader, and as a public servant he has set an example for others to follow; NOW, THEREFORE,
