

RESOLUTION NUMBER R-286737

ADOPTED ON DECEMBER 5, 1995

RESOLUTION CONSIDERING THE PROTESTS,
APPROVING MODIFIED MAP, CONFIRMING THE
ASSESSMENTS, AND ORDERING THE PROPOSED
MAINTENANCE, IN THE MATTER OF THE FEDERAL
BOULEVARD LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the notice of the time and place fixed for the hearing of protests in the matter of "Federal Boulevard Landscape Maintenance District," under Resolution of Intention No. R-286436, adopted on October 16, 1995, having been duly given in the manner required by law and the legal time for filing such protests and the time fixed for hearing thereon having passed; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the name of this district shall be known as the "Webster-Federal Blvd. Landscape Maintenance District."
2. That the protests, if any, are overruled.
3. The assessments described in Document No. RR-286437, on file in the office of the City Clerk and on file in the office of the Street Superintendent, are hereby confirmed and approved.
4. The modified assessment district map for the "Federal Boulevard Landscape Maintenance District," described in Document No. M-0375-2 is hereby approved.


5. That the maintenance described in said Resolution of Intention is hereby ordered performed.

6. That the City Manager is directed to coordinate with San Diego Gas and Electric Company so that undergrounding of cables is consistent with the beautification project and will not precipitate any delay.

7. That the City Manager is directed to work with Derryl Williams of the Webster Community Council with respect to the responsibility for the maintenance.
