AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH SAN DIEGO COUNTY WATER AUTHORITY TO EFFECT THE EXCHANGE OF THE CANYON BRIDGE IN MISSION TRAILS REGIONAL PARK FOR THREE ACCESS EASEMENTS WITHIN MISSION TRAILS REGIONAL PARK

WHEREAS, the Canyon Bridge, located within Mission Trails Regional Park at the east end of Clairemont Mesa Boulevard, is a pre-fabricated steel bridge, 14 feet wide and 315 feet in length, with concrete abutments, and was installed in late 1994 to provide temporary construction access to the San Diego County Water Authority's (SDCWA) construction site; and


WHEREAS, the City permitted the temporary bridge to be installed and the City now desires to acquire the Canyon Bridge and in addition retain two graded staging areas for park use, in exchange for which SDCWA has requested three access easements; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute, for and on behalf of The City of San Diego, an agreement with SDCWA for the exchange of the Canyon Bridge in Mission Trails Regional Park, for three access easements within Mission Trails Regional Park, under the terms and conditions set forth in that agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No.

OO- 18249 .

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
