

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 18360 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON NOV 12 1996

AN ORDINANCE AWARDING NONEXCLUSIVE FRANCHISES TO AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A NONEXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT WITH EACH AND ALL OF SEVENTEEN (17) CURRENTLY LICENSED HAULERS UPON COMPLETION OF APPLICATION AND ALL REQUIREMENTS CONTAINED IN THE NONEXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE ORDINANCE AND AGREEMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:


