ADOPTED ON JAN 16 1996

WHEREAS, Father Joseph O'Hare became the 31st President of Fordham University on July 1, 1985; and

WHEREAS, Father O'Hare has been appointed one of two American council members to the International Federation of Catholic Universities; and

WHEREAS, Father O'Hare was appointed by Mayor Edward I. Koch to the Campaign Finance Board, a five-member non-partisan board created to oversee a new law on voluntary public financing of municipal elections established by the New York City Council, and he was reappointed to this position in January 1994 by Mayor Rudolph Giuliani; and

WHEREAS, Father Joseph O'Hare was honored by his colleagues in 1994 with the Award for Distinguished Achievement; and


