

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 286849

ADOPTED ON JAN 29 1996

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego's current contracting methods often preclude small contractors from participating on City contracts as prime contractors; and

WHEREAS, the Contract Sizing Task Force, pursuant to City Council recommendation, reviewed and categorized the types of projects currently in the bid process for potential sizing changes; and

WHEREAS, the Contracting Sizing Task Force reviewed the advantages and disadvantages of contract sizing as they apply to City contracts; and

WHEREAS, after the review was completed, the Contract Sizing Task Force formed a Contract Sizing Pilot Program to determine the effectiveness of such a program; and

WHEREAS, the Task Force will select three (3) projects. A specific project will be identified by Public Buildings and Park Design, Transportation and Drainage Design, and Water and Wastewater Facilities Divisions. Each project selected will be sized into smaller distinct packages to be bid on separately; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Contract Sizing Task Force recommendations are approved in concept for implementation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Contract Sizing Task Force's recommendation to establish a pilot program be discussed further in the Rules Committee before it is submitted for final approval to the City Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Contract Sizing Task Force monitor the projects and report to The City Council on the results of the program.
