WHEREAS, it is the policy of the San Diego City Council to encourage and support voter registration programs throughout San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego recognizes that the voice of each citizen is heard through the power of their vote; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Diego has 600,000 eligible but unregistered voters; and

WHEREAS, the Registrar of Voters Office, along with individuals and organizations throughout the County of San Diego, have joined together to form community partnerships to register voters; and

WHEREAS, the deadline for new voters and for current voters who have changed name, address, or political affiliation to register to vote in the March 26, 1996, primary is February 26, 1996; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Mayor and Council do hereby proclaim February 10, 1996, to be "GO FOR THE VOTE DAY" in San Diego and call upon citizens

to observe this day through participation in voter registration efforts and by voting in this major election.
