WHEREAS, the La Jolla Chamber Music Society has recognized the financial crisis in San Diego schools which has led to the elimination of many music and arts education curricula and left thousands of students without any music program at all in the schools; and

WHEREAS, the La Jolla Chamber Music Society acknowledges the direct correlation between music training and academic performance, including spacial reasoning ability and IQ scores; and

WHEREAS, the La Jolla Chamber Music Society has responded to the needs of San Diego children by creating the Discovery Series, an innovative educational outreach program which has reached more than 70,000 students who may not otherwise have been exposed to classical music; and

WHEREAS, the La Jolla Chamber Music Society also offers free chamber music concerts of the finest quality to students and provides a unique opportunity for interaction between the children and the artists; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,

that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, hereby supports the efforts of the La Jolla Chamber Music Society to encourage and promote the limitless educational potential of classical music for the children of San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that February 12, 1996 be and is hereby proclaimed to be "LA JOLLA CHAMBER MUSIC SOCIETY DAY" in The City of San Diego.
