

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 286961

ADOPTED ON MAR 04 1996

WHEREAS, the University City Foundation for Public Schools ("Foundation") is a California nonprofit foundation established to deepen and enrich the learning environment of all children in Doyle Elementary, Spreckels Elementary, Curie Elementary, Standley Middle, and University City High Schools; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation has played an integral part in getting the five University City schools to work collectively in improving public awareness of the schools and their importance to the community; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation builds and fosters a rich and satisfying learning environment by bringing together the parents, community, businesses, and children of the University City neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation is entirely staffed by volunteers and is the first multi-school foundation within the San Diego Unified School District; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation has gained strength and momentum in just three years; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation's annual "Taste of the Triangle" community event and other activities have raised nearly \$40,000 to supplement the resources of the University City public schools; and

WHEREAS, all funds raised at the "Taste of the Triangle"

event by the Foundation are disbursed to the schools via a three-tier grant process to engender the greatest support for the children of University City in the classroom, school, or community; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby recognize the directors and all volunteers for their personal contribution to improving the learning environment for all children attending University City public schools through the University City Foundation for Public Schools.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Monday, March 4, 1996 be and is hereby proclaimed to be "UNIVERSITY CITY FOUNDATION FOR PUBLIC SCHOOLS DAY" in The City of San Diego.
