RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO FILE AN APPLICATION FOR SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FOR THE GRADE SEPARATION PROJECT, WIDENING OF THE BRIDGE ON MIRAMAR ROAD OVER THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILROAD.

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego completed the widening of the railroad bridge on Miramar Road over the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad, CIP 53-042.0 (Project), with the filing of a Certificate of Completion and Acceptance with the Recorder for the County of San Diego, as Document 89 364608, on July 11, 1989; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the Project was \$1,009,769.38, which exceeded the original estimate of \$600,000; and

WHEREAS, all of the costs of the Project were necessary to complete the Project and those costs have been outlined in the supplemental application; and

WHEREAS, the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad has contributed ten percent (10%) of the actual cost of the Project per agreement (Document No. RR-265345); and


WHEREAS, through agreement (Document No. RR-266679), the State of California Department of Transportation (CalTrans) has contributed eighty percent (80%) of the original estimate to construct; and

WHEREAS, there is provision within TITLE 21, Subchapter 13 of the California State Code for supplemental funding for grade separation projects; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
that the City Manager is hereby authorized to file with CalTrans
an application for additional funding for the Project. The
additional funds will bring the CalTrans contribution to eighty
percent (80%) of the actual cost of construction.
