WHEREAS, it is now deemed necessary and appropriate to designate said Management Team for The City of San Diego for such meet and confer purposes; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that pursuant to appropriate and applicable provisions of law and Council Policy, the following persons are hereby appointed

and designated as the Management Team for purposes of meeting and conferring with recognized employee organizations:

Cathy Lexin, Labor Relations Manager

Bill R. Lopez, Management Assistant

Agnes Generoso, Management Assistant

John M. Kaheny, Assistant City Attorney

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Personnel Director is hereby appointed as a member of the Management Team, pursuant to the above cited provisions of law and Council Policy 300-6, for all purposes except meeting and conferring with employee organizations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council approve the City Manager's recommendations, and continue to use the Retirement Administrator as an advisor to the members of the Management Team on retirement issues pending a potential determination to include the Retirement Administrator on the Management Team.
