

RESOLUTION NUMBER R-287318

ADOPTED ON MAY 14, 1996

WHEREAS, on April 25, 1996, CARTER-REESE AND ASSOCIATES, a California general partnership, submitted an application to the Development Services Department for a Resource Protection Ordinance Permit, Mid-City Communities Development Permit, Tentative Map and the vacation of a portion of Brant Street, Laurel Street and the northeast corner of the subject property; and

WHEREAS, the permit was set for a public hearing to be conducted by the Council of The City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the issue was heard by the City Council on May 14, 1996; and


WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego considered the issues discussed in Negative Declaration DEP No. 95-0685; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that it is hereby certified that Negative Declaration DEP No. 95-0685, on file in the office of the City Clerk, has been completed in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 (California Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), as amended, and the State guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations section 15000 et seq.), that the declaration reflects the independent judgment of The City of San Diego as Lead Agency and that the information contained in the report,

together with any comments received during the public review process, has been reviewed and considered by this Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council finds that, based upon the Initial Study and any comments received, that there is no substantial evidence that the project will have a significant effect on the environment and, therefore, that said Negative Declaration is hereby approved.
