

RESOLUTION NUMBER R-287341

ADOPTED ON MAY 28 1996

WHEREAS, the San Diego Job Corps Center was established in October of 1978 and is dedicated to job training and placement for young people who are 16-24 years of age; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Job Corps Center is a national program operated by Career Systems Development Corporation for the United States Department of Labor and operates a residential program which provides basic education and vocational classes for students in over twenty trade occupations including the opportunity to get a high school equivalency diploma; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Job Corps Center benefits the City and County of San Diego by providing employment for over 250 full-time positions and over 50% of the students served are from within the San Diego County region; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Job Corps Center has been ranked one of the top eight centers in the country by the U.S. Department of Labor; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Job Corps Center students annually perform services to various nonprofits in the community and in 1995-96 donated more than \$60,000 in services to community events and construction projects including improvements to community parks and area schools; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego,

does hereby recognize the outstanding contributions that the San Diego Job Corps Center has made to improving the lives of young people in the area of job training and placement and supports the Center's continued existence in San Diego County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that May 28, 1996 be and is hereby proclaimed to be "**SAN DIEGO JOB CORPS CENTER DAY**" in The City of San Diego.
