

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 287491
ADOPTED ON JUN 10 1996

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DIRECTING ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS OF THE EDUCATION, HISTORIC CORE, AND WATERFRONT/RECREATION SUBAREAS OF THE NAVAL TRAINING CENTER REUSE CONCEPT PLAN.

WHEREAS, in 1993 the Base Realignment and Closure Commission recommended, and Congress and the President approved, the closure of a substantial portion of the Naval Training Center military installation ("NTC") located in the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego (the "Council") has been officially recognized by the United States Department of Defense as the Local Redevelopment Authority ("LRA") responsible for the closure of NTC; and

WHEREAS, a Reuse Concept Plan has been approved by the Naval Training Center Reuse Committee, a citizens advisory group to the LRA, which contains Education, Historic Core, and Waterfront/Recreation Subareas and includes a Statement of Policies and Priorities for each of these subareas; and


WHEREAS, the Council has considered the recommendations of the Naval Training Center Reuse Committee and all maps, exhibits, and written documents pertaining to these subareas of the NTC Reuse Concept Plan on record in the City of San Diego, and has considered the oral presentations given at the public meeting;
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the words "viable water and shoreline habitat" be substituted for the words "viable water habitat" on page 4 of the Statement of Policies and Procedures contained in the Reuse Concept Plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council, as the LRA, directs that environmental analysis be conducted in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") and the National Environmental Policy Act ("NEPA") for the Education, Historic Core, and Waterfront/ Recreation Subareas of the NTC Reuse Concept Plan, as amended above, as the preferred alternative in the environmental documents.
