ADOPTED ON JUN 24 1996

WHEREAS, the North Park Lions Club will celebrate its 70th Anniversary in 1996 as the community recognizes the 100th Anniversary of the establishment of North Park as the first suburb of The City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,  
that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego,  
does hereby recognize the outstanding contributions that the  
North Park Lions Club has made to improving the lives of  
residents of North Park and The City of San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Monday, June 17, 1996 be and is  
hereby proclaimed to be "NORTH PARK LIONS CLUB DAY" in The City  
of San Diego.
