RESOLUTION NUMBER R-287561 ADOPTED ON JUNE 25, 1996

WHEREAS, citizens throughout the San Diego County region rely on their community libraries for a variety of services; and

WHEREAS, legislation is needed to authorize the voters of San Diego County to vote to impose a sales tax to be used exclusively for library purposes; and

WHEREAS, urgency legislation is needed before August 9, 1996, to permit the Board of Supervisors to place the ballot measure on the November 5, 1996 ballot; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council hereby supports the adoption of urgency legislation to permit the voters of San Diego County to consider a one-quarter cent sales tax rate increase for five years to be used exclusively for library improvements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Council urges all members of the San Diego Legislative Delegation and the Governor to support such legislation.
