

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 287702

ADOPTED ON JUL 30 1996

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO LEVYING AN ANNUAL ASSESSMENT WITHIN PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICTS FOR JULY 1, 1996, THROUGH JUNE 30, 1997 (FY 1997).

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego (the "Council"), in accordance with the Parking and Business Improvement Association Law of 1989 (Streets and Highways Code section 36500 et seq.) wishes to continue the promotional activities within existing business improvement districts (the "districts"); and

WHEREAS, the Council, on June 3, 1996, by Resolution No. R-287452, set the date of June 25, 1996, at the hour of 10:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, 202 C Street, San Diego, California, as the time and place when and where any and all interested persons having a desire to be heard may appear and state their views for or against the continuance of each district or the furnishing of specific types of improvements or activities within each district; and

WHEREAS, the Council, on June 3, 1996, by Resolution No. R-287451, accepted the budget report for each business improvement district within the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, on June 25, 1996, the Council approved the annual assessments for the Business Improvement Districts listed in

Resolution No. R-287452 with the exception the Diamond Business Improvement District; and


WHEREAS, approval of the Diamond Business Improvement District was continued for 30 days, at the request of Councilmember Stevens, to determine why the Diamond Business Improvement District fees are much higher when compared to the other assessments; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Council hereby confirms the Diamond Business Improvement District budget report as set forth in Document No. RR-287702 on file in the office of the City Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the adoption of this resolution shall constitute the levy of assessment for Fiscal Year 1997 as referred to in the Diamond Business Improvement District report.
