

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 287719

ADOPTED ON AUG 0 5 1996

WHEREAS, beginning August 18, and culminating on August 26, 1996, the people of Pacific Beach will inaugurate Pacific Beach Family Week with various events that offer unique opportunities to help re-establish a healthy, wholesome family environment in this community; and

WHEREAS, Pacific Beach Family Week has been organized by Partners in Literacy, which provides support for four elementary schools in Pacific Beach: Bay View Terrace, Kate Sessions, Pacific Beach and Crown Point; and

WHEREAS, several admirable organizations have donated valuable time and effort to make the first Pacific Beach Family Week a success; and

WHEREAS, Beach Business Cooperative, Columbia Mission Bay Hospital, Pacific Beach Kiwanis Club, Pacific Beach Lions Club, Rotary Club of Mission Bay, Pacific Beach Business Improvement Association, Pacific Beach Chamber of Commerce, and the Pacific Beach Town Council are commended for their indispensable participation; and

WHEREAS, many businesses have also contributed to the exciting variety of Pacific Beach Family Week events, including Aladdin Carpet Cleaning, Beach & Bay Press, Belmont Park, Blind Melons, Bullseye Painting, the historic Crystal Pier Hotel and the Bill Allen Family, Tom Cajka-CPA, Carincross Management,

Pacific Plaza, Copy World, Dairy Queen, Yum Yum Donuts, Patrick Flynn-Attorney at Law, Firehouse Beach Cafe, Fox 1 Hour Photo, Grand Avenue Chiropractic, Hollandia Dairy, Jiffy Lube, La Boheme, Longs Drug Store, Peninsula Bank, Rubio's Restaurants, Service America, Rick Shwisberg-Attorney at Law, Video Land, and Zanzibar Coffee Company; and

WHEREAS, on Sunday, August 18, 1996, Pacific Beach Family Week will begin with "Church Day," a special day for local centers of worship to focus their services on the importance of family unity, with special emphasis on children; and

WHEREAS, on Monday, August 19, 1996, an early evening sing-along will be held in Kate Sessions Park; and on the morning of Tuesday, August 20, 1996, a children's reading hour will be held at the Pacific Beach Library, providing parents the opportunity to apply for their child's first library card; and

WHEREAS, on Wednesday, August 21, 1996, the film "E.T. - the Extraterrestrial" will be shown on the beach; and on Thursday, August 22, 1996, Belmont Park hosts Family Day by providing families a day of thrilling rides, amusements, and entertainment; and Friday, August 23, 1996, will include Lifeguard Relay Races at Crystal Pier; and

WHEREAS, on Saturday, August 24, 1996, a Family Festival Day will be held at Pacific Beach Middle School, including a pancake breakfast sponsored by the Rotary Club to benefit Friends of the Pacific Beach Library; and

WHEREAS, the festival will have rides and displays, and a Health Fair hosted by Mission Bay Hospital; and on Sunday, August


25, 1996, Pacific Beach Family Week concludes with an outdoor concert in Kate Sessions Park, hosted by the Pacific Beach Town Council; and
