## RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 287785 ADOPTED ON SEP 0 9 1996

WHEREAS, The California Arts Council has offered The City of San Diego a grant under the auspices of its Technical Assistance Program ("Program") "to provide a musical education experience for elementary school youth in Logan Heights, Sherman Heights and the Golden Hill area" as part of the City of San Diego Commission for Arts and Culture's Neighborhood Arts Program; and

WHEREAS, the objective of the grant is to provide sixty 4th, 5th and 6th grade students with an after-school music education program; and

WHEREAS, the long range goals of this music education project are:

- 1. to serve as a model for reduplication in two other target areas in San Diego;
  - 2. that it will continue as a "center;"
- 3. that it will develop as a "performing arts center" for Logan Heights, Sherman Heights, Golden Hill, and neighboring communities in San Diego;
- 4. that it will serve as a channel for cultural entities to draw non-traditional audiences to concerts; and

WHEREAS, the grant will be used to pay five music teachers, who will teach violin, guitar, clarinet/flute, trumpet and percussion; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego that the City Manager be and he'is hereby authorized to accept funds

in the amount of \$10,150 from the California Arts Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to administer these grant funds received from the California Arts Council for the purposes described above.
