

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 287847

ADOPTED ON SEP 30 1996

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego recognizes that code enforcement plays an integral role in maintaining a high quality of life for San Diegans by increasing the public's safety, preventing deterioration and blight in neighborhoods, and protecting property values throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, it is the purpose of the City of San Diego:

(1) To foster standards, both professional and educational, for all persons employed in or performing duties which relate to or depend upon knowledge of code enforcement procedures and regulations;

(2) To foster continued mutual support among members, volunteers and community groups, and to further promote and develop the code enforcement profession;

(3) To continue to work in partnership with the people of San Diego to vigorously enforce our code enforcement laws and thereby improve the quality of San Diego's neighborhoods and maintain a safe and desirable living and working environment; and


