

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 287849

ADOPTED ON SEP 30 1996

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego that the specifications for the furnishing of all labor, material, tools, equipment, transportation and other expense necessary or incidental for RECONSTRUCTION OF BALBOA PARK GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE BUILDING, San Diego, California, on file in the Office of the City Clerk of San Diego, California on SEP 30 1996, and bearing official document No.


W.O. 112105, be and the same are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Contract Services Division of the City of San Diego be, and is hereby authorized and directed to proceed to publish in accordance with the law, notice to contractors calling for bids for the work hereinabove described, in accordance with the plans and specifications hereinabove referred to.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for RECONSTRUCTION OF BALBOA PARK GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE BUILDING, provided that the City Auditor first furnishes a certificate demonstrating that the funds necessary for such expenditure are, or will be, on deposit in the City Treasury.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; that the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to transfer \$425,000.00 from CIP No. 29-704.0, GOLF COURSE ENTERPRISE FUND NO. 41400, to CIP No. 21-842.0, BALBOA PARK GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE BUILDING; and authorizing the expenditure of \$723,750.00 from CIP No. 21-842.0, BALBOA PARK GOLF COURSE, \$298,750.00 from Golf Course Enterprise Fund No. 41401, and \$425,000.00 from Golf Course Enterprise Fund No. 41400, is hereby authorized solely and exclusively for providing funds for said project and related costs, provided that the City Auditor first furnishes a certificate demonstrating that the funds necessary for such expenditure are, or will be, on deposit in the City treasury, and authorizing the Auditor and Comptroller upon advice from the administering department, to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.
