WHEREAS, Charlie Cox's volunteer efforts, through the Policy Department's RSVP Program, made the San Diego Housing Commission's Address Match Program an award winning program that prevents drug and violent activity in subsidized housing; and

WHEREAS, on his own time and computer, Charlie Cox developed a computer software program that cross checks police arrests for drug and violent crimes against Section 8 and Public Housing addresses; and

WHEREAS, Charlie Cox consistently and promptly sends matched addresses involving drug and violent arrest information to the San Diego Housing Commission; and


WHEREAS, Charlie Cox's volunteer effort enables the San Diego Housing Commission to enforce its Zero-Tolerance Policy among assisted households; and

WHEREAS, Charlie Cox's efforts make the partnership between the San Diego Police Department and San Diego Housing Commission in the fight against drugs and violent crimes in subsidized housing a model for other cities to follow; NOW, THEREFORE,
