## RESOLUTION NUMBER R-\_ 287947 ADOPTED ON OCT 21 1996

WHEREAS, the State of California has passed Assembly Bill (AB) 3229, 
"Citizens' Option for Public Safety" to supplement the front line law enforcement 
resources of local jurisdictions throughout the State with no requirement for matching 
funds; and

WHEREAS, funds for AB 3229 have been appropriated for Fiscal Year 1996/97, and the amount allocated to the San Diego Police Department is two million, seven hundred fifty three thousand, seventeen dollars (\$2,753,017.00); and

WHEREAS, AB 3229 requires that the City Council appropriate these funds in accordance with a written request submitted by the Chief of Police; and

WHEREAS, AB 3229 requires that the City set up a Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Fund to receive and expend these funds; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City

Manager be and is hereby authorized and empowered, for and on behalf of the City of

San Diego, to apply for and accept these Citizens' Options for Public Safety Grant

funds from the State of California;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the City

Manager to set up a Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Fund to receive and

expend these funds;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the City

Manager to expend these funds in the manner set forth by the Chief of Police in the

attached Manager's Report, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. 287947, and to execute all aspects of program operation including any amendments and extensions, and to certify that the City will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to said program;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any resources received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
