AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CORNERSTONE LANDS CONSERVATION BANK AGREEMENT WITH CDFG AND USFWS TO PRESERVE WATER UTILITY LANDS.


BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of the City, the Cornerstone Lands Conservation Bank Agreement (the "Agreement") with the California Department of Fish and Game ("CDFG") and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service ("USFWS") to conserve certain Water Utility lands, contingent upon CDFG and USFWS approval of the Agreement in substantially the same form as recommended by the City Manager in Attachment 5 of the City Manager's Memorandum to the Honorable Mayor and City Council dated March 12, 1997, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No.

RR- 288455-4 [Resolution No. R-288455].

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
