AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VIII, ARTICLE 4, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 84.12 RELATING TO MISCELLANEOUS DRIVING RULES, USE OF SKATEBOARDS, COASTERS, ROLLER SKATES, AND SIMILAR DEVICES RESTRICTED.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VIII, Article 4, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 84.12, to read as follows:

SEC. 84.12 Use of Skateboards, Coasters, Roller Skates, and Similar Devices Restricted

- (a) It is unlawful for any person riding on roller skates or by means of a coaster, skateboard, toy vehicle, or similar device to go upon an open roadway in the City of San Diego, or upon the sidewalk or public plaza in any business district, or upon any inclined surface area of any City-owned or privately owned parkade where signs forbidding such activity are displayed at the ground level elevator entrance and at each vehicular entrance to the parkade.
- (b) Between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., it is unlawful for any person riding on or by means of a coaster, skateboard, toy vehicle, or similar device to go upon: (1) any portion of public rights-of-way within the Mission

 Beach community, as defined by the Community Planning Area Map, as designated on Map Drawing No. C:637113 on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document

No. 768482; or, (2) any portion of the most westerly public walkway between San Diego Place on the south and Law Street on the north, known as Ocean Front Walk or Ocean Boulevard, or to go upon the public walkway immediately adjacent to the bay extending from the Mission Beach community, around Sail Bay, through Crown Point Shores, as designated on the map on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-_____18425
