AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, REQUIRING ITS REPRESENTATIVES TO THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY WATER AUTHORITY TO CAST THE CITY'S VOTE AS A UNIT.

WHEREAS, section 6 of the County Water Authority Act (Chapter 545 of the Statutes of 1943, Chapter 45 Water Code-Appendix) provides that a public agency with more than one representative to the Board of Directors of the San Diego County Water Authority shall have the option to determine by ordinance how its representatives shall cast that agency's votes; and

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego has determined to require that its representatives cast all of the City's votes as a unit, as a majority of the representatives present shall determine; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals are true and correct.

Section 2. That The City of San Diego hereby exercises its option under section 6(e) of the County Water Authority Act to require its representatives to cast all of the City's votes as a unit, as a majority of the representatives present shall determine.

Section 3. That the City Clerk of the Council of The City of San Diego is directed to forward a certified true copy of this ordinance to the Board Secretary of the San Diego County Water Authority.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
