RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 288268

ADOPTED ON JAN 27 1997

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) has made available funds from the Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994 in the form of Local Law Enforcement Block Grants allocated based on population; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego Police Department is eligible to apply for block grant funds in the amount of two million, nine hundred forty eight thousand, one hundred one dollars (\$2,948,101.00); and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used for technological improvements in the ability of police officers to provide law enforcement, crime prevention and community policing services; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Manager be and is hereby authorized and empowered, for and on behalf of the City of San Diego, to apply for, accept and expend said block grant funds for the above-named purpose as described in the grant proposal, a copy of which is attached and is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute all aspects of program operation including any amendments, extensions, or renewals for a period of up to five years, provided funding is made available by the United States Department of Justice, Office of community Oriented Policing Services (COPS), and to certify that the City will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to said program;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager be, and is hereby authorized to commit the required matching funds congruent with the requirements of the Local Law Enforcement Block grant program;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any resources received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that personnel positions funded under this grant are not subject to local hiring freezes;
