

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 288512 (R-97-960)

ADOPTED ON APR 07 1997

WHEREAS, in 1991, The City of San Diego executed a right-of-entry permit with the International Boundary and Water Commission (the "Commission") for the installation of a groundwater monitoring well located on City-owned property at the San Ysidro border crossing; and

WHEREAS, the permit is currently on a month-to-month hold over; and

WHEREAS, the Commission recently requested a new permit for continued use of the well through July 31, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the ground water monitoring is required as mitigation for construction of the South Bay International Wastewater Treatment Plant, in which the City has also participated;


NOW, THEREFORE,
