

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 288552

ADOPTED ON APR 15 1997

WHEREAS, in March 1993 the Mayor and Council of The City of San Diego directed the City Manager to streamline the permit processing system to make it more "business friendly" by reducing the time it takes to obtain a permit and where appropriate, converting fees charged in obtaining a permit from a deposit account system to a fixed or flat rate system, in order to provide potential permit holders with greater cost predictability; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with that direction, on November 20, 1996, the Land Use and Housing Committee approved the City Manager's recommendation that a tiered fee structure for certain Coastal Development Permits ("CDPs") be adopted by the City Council; NOW,

THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That it hereby approves the conversion of deposit accounts to flat fees for single family residential remodels and construction of new single family residences which require only a Coastal Development Permit and have an Environmental Determination of Exempt or Negative Declaration without mitigation requirements, as more fully set out in City Manager's Report

2. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to amend the Rate Book to reflect the above-mentioned conversion to a flat fee system.
