WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Community

Oriented Policing Services (COPS) has made funds available for the development of problem
solving partnerships between law enforcement agencies and community organizations with funds
provided by The Violent Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994 (the Crime Act); and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego Police Department (SDPD), has developed a partnership with the San Diego Organizing Project (SDOP), the goals of which are to empower neighborhoods and residents to combat crime and disorder through the use of problem-solving strategies; and

WHEREAS, SDPD and SDOP have developed a joint program plan which will provide SDPD with electronic access to certain SDPD crime, enforcement and problem-solving information which will facilitate the crime prevention training activities of SDOP; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager be and is hereby authorized and empowered, for and on behalf of the City of San Diego, to apply for, accept and expend a grant from DOJ/COPS in partnership with SDOP for the above-referenced program, a copy of which proposal is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document Nd. 288565

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, should the City be selected to receive said grant, an agreement between City and SDOP shall be drafted and processed as a separate document, in

accordance with City regulations;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute all aspects of grant program operation including any amendments, extensions, renewals, or future funding for this program for a period of up to five years, provided funding is made available by DOJ/COPS, and to certify that the City will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to said program;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any grant funded City staff positions shall not be subject to local hiring freezes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any resources received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
