A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE APPLICATIONS FOR GRANT FUNDING TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA NATURAL COMMUNITY CONSERVATION PLANNING GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE FOLLOWING PROJECTS: CARMEL VALLEY/CARMEL MOUNTAIN ACQUISITION, SAN DIEGO AMBROSIA MANAGEMENT AND AUTECOLOGICAL STUDIES, OTAY VERNAL POOL/COASTAL SAGE SCRUB ACQUISITION AND RESTORATION, AND THE ROSE CANYON OPEN SPACE PARK RIPARIAN HABITAT ENHANCEMENT.

WHEREAS, the State of California has implemented the Natural Community Conservation Planning ("NCCP") Program, to provide grant funding to projects that assist local governments in establishing and implementing local NCCP plans; and

WHEREAS, the Multiple Species Conservation Program ("MSCP") is in the approval stages of qualifying as a State recognized NCCP Program; and

WHEREAS, the NCCP Program has established the procedures and criteria for reviewing and awarding grant proposals; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego as a grant applicant, if selected, will enter into an agreement with State of California NCCP Program; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That it hereby approves the filing of the four grant applications of the NCCP Program in substantially the same form as set forth in the document titled City of San Diego NCCP Grant Proposal, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 288725


2. That it hereby certifies that the City understands the assurances and certifications in the grant applications.

3. That it authorizes the City Manager and City Attorney to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned projects.

4. That it hereby authorizes the City Manager to accept and expend funds in accordance with the grants, if the grants are awarded.

5. That it hereby authorizes the Auditor and Comptroller to establish separate interest-bearing accounts.
